Tre Monti Ristorante is open weekdays for lunch service 11:30 AM- 4 PM. Lunch prices range from \$8- \$18. Dinner is served seven days a week from 4 PM to 10PM on Mondays, Tuesdays Wednesday and Sundays and until 11PM on Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays. Bar service is available until midnight on Fridays and Saturdays.

The new lunch menu features fare that is light, fresh and affordable including a tuna roll up, panino bambino and a grilled vegetarian sandwich and seven varieties of brick oven pizza, entrée salads, soups, and fresh chicken and fish selections. There are also daily specials. Executive Chef Richard Conover promises that everyone will return to work recharged. “We bypass heavy creams and sauces so you really delight in the flavors,” he reports.

Tre Monti Ristorante is named for the three- peaked 2,437 feet high Mont Titano which dominates the beautiful country of San Marino which is completely landlocked by Italy
